

BUFFALO JONESBORO CEMETERY, INC.

Restrictions, Rules and Regulations

1. Persons in charge of funeral arrangements must contact Buffalo-Jonesboro Cemetery manager 48 hours in advance to schedule services and get grave site ownership verified and grave laid out. Plots will only be opened and closed at the direction of cemetery management, and by persons contracted with the cemetery.
2. All grave sites must be paid in full at the time of purchase.
3. All graves will be opened and closed only by persons authorized by Buffalo-Jonesboro Cemetery and paid in advance at rate in effect the day of opening and closing.
4. All graves' depth shall be according to state code at time of use of at least seventeen (17) inches below ground level. Adult graves' opening may not be over ninety-two inches (92") long and forty (40) inches wide. Cremations and or cremation vaults are to be at least seventeen (17) inches below ground level.
5. A vault or grave liner must be used except in the case of cremation remains.
6. Grave plots may contain up to one (1) traditional burial and one (1) cremation burial, or two (2) cremation burials. All burials must stay within the ninety-two (92) inches by forty (40) inches vault dimensions. An opening and closing fee per application will apply.
7. All headstones shall be of natural stone and shall be placed along the west side of the lot. The only other allowable permanent monument shall be a footstone at ground level.
8. No monument is to be installed during extreme wet or cold conditions. The base cannot exceed forty two inches (42") in length by sixteen inches (16") in width for single markers and eighty-four inches (84") in length by sixteen inches (16") in width for double markers (no exceptions).
9. Cultivation of live shrubs and plants is not permitted. Buffalo-Jonesboro Cemetery reserves the right to prune, remove, or transplant any shrub, plant or vine as it in its sole discretion determines.
10. Buffalo-Jonesboro is not responsible for the sale or installation of monuments or grave markers and is not responsible for any maintenance or vandalism which occurs on property deeded to an individual.
11. Private mausoleums are expressly prohibited at Buffalo-Jonesboro Cemetery.
12. Plots are to be used only for the burial of human remains.
13. No unleashed or unattended dogs or pets are allowed on Buffalo-Jonesboro Cemetery property and all visitors shall observe any applicable leash ordinances.
14. No items are allowed on grave sites except those placed on grave markers. Buffalo-Jonesboro Cemetery Inc. reserves the right to remove floral designs, flowers, plants, or other items management deems inappropriate from grave markers and plots.
15. The cemetery is closed between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
